THREAT OF STRIKE BY THE NLC/TUC ON GOVERNMENT'S PERCEIVED INACTION ON THE NATIONAL MINIMUM WAGE REVIEW

As you are aware, the Central Labour Unions had given the Federal Government a 14 days ultimatum and a threat to proceed on a strike action with effect from Wednesday, 25th September 2018 due to perceived Government complicity in the delay in concluding the works of the National Minimum Wage (NMW) Committee.

We have been in constant touch with the leadership of the Labour Unions and have been assured the target of the strike action is not the Private Sector but Government and its institutions. The Federal Government on its part is consulting with the Unions to prevail on them to shelve the planned action.

In the light of the feedbacks that we have received from NLC and TUC, we advise member-companies to sensitize their workers to the effect that the Private Sector has no problem with the Unions and, as such, not the target of the Industrial action. Workers should be informed that they are all, therefore, expected to be at their duty posts promptly.

We urge you to treat this situation with care by ensuring you adopt the right disposition and communication to your workers ahead of time.
